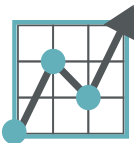

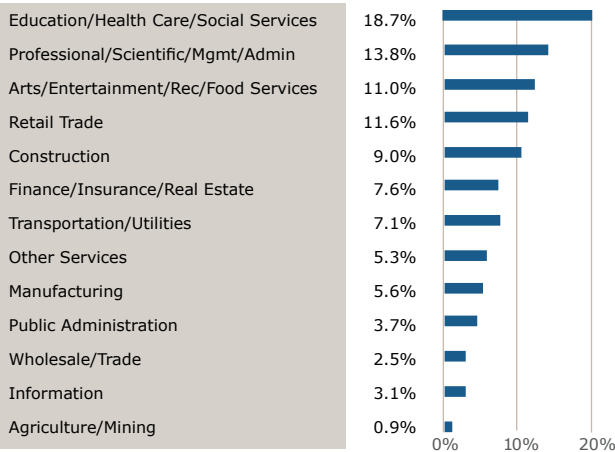

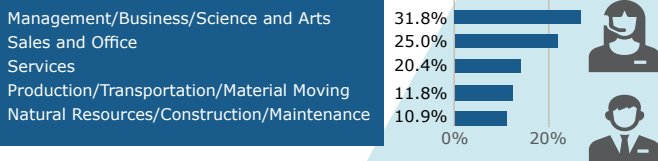

OCCUPATION BREAKDOWN BY %

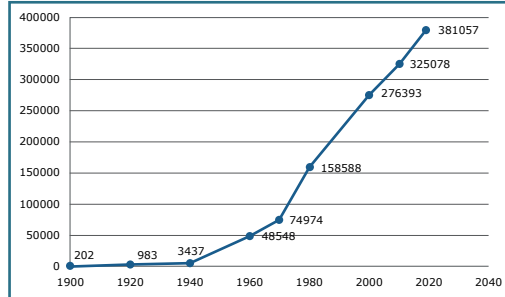

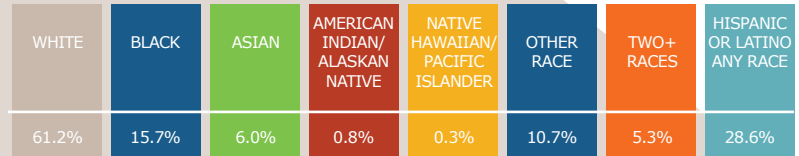
